Stop It All by Karen Ruggles (Starter Pack 1x 250ml oil + 1x 250ml shampoo)

The Blurb: This single product can repel flies and mosquitoes, lice, ticks, leg and ear mites. When used in tandem with the mild, Hypoallergenic Shampoo, it can also be used for all issues connected to

flies/mossies and summer itching, mud environments, scabs, hair loss, strike by flying critters, minor wounds, scurfy skin, hot skin, head lice, body sores and general skin unhappiness as well as acting as a natural antifeedant for

insects that normally eat plants. The oil (with a nutty/garlic/burnt coffee/onion aroma) is blended here in Somerset (UK) and is a mixture of tropical vegetable oils including Coconut, Safflower, Neem, etc. Scientifically identified properties include our oil ingredients being resistant to more than 300 different

insect types. It can aid swellings and repel bugs, calm & moisturise skin. The key ingredients are ANTIbacterial, fungal and oxidant. They are also naturally biodegradable.

Verdict: Well I have to be honest. This product did not convince me when I heard about it. It completely proved me wrong. I used the oil as an alternative to Spot On for my horse; I also diluted it as instructed to make a fly spray. I used the shampoo as a general shampoo on my horse. My friend tried the shampoo and oil on her horse that has same lithing. I used the shampoo on my dogs and used the oil on ticks. It all worked! Brilliant fly spray/spot on and cheaper than xxxxxxxxxxxxxx the vets, and applied in much the same way. It lasted on my horse as a spot on for about 6 days.

The oil even repelled ticks off my dog immediately. The only downside, the oil smells

quite strong. I used the diluted spray around my tent as a midge repellent too. I am shocked it works so well. It did not cure my friend's sumet liding with one use but it certainly eased it.
